### **A Newly-Formed Life Sciences Firm**

After a merger with another entity, the leading life sciences company needed to select a single document management system for its consolidated legal department. Before the merger, the legal departments took very different approaches to document management. One embraced a web-based system while the other used iManage Work on-premises system. Post merger, they knew they needed to standardize on a single solution to optimize productivity and collaboration across legal teams. The document management system would primarily support its contracts management and intellectual property (IP) management groups. The contracts team needed a solution that could track changes within multiple versions of a contract document and the IP team needed a solution that could store patent documents within a specific hierarchy.

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### Web-Based Document Management Falls Short

In their quest for a single, comprehensive and easy-to-use document management system, Jaime Gamarra, senior associate systems analyst for IT legal applications and his team evaluated the web-based option, but concluded that it lacked key usability features. For example, Gamarra found it cumbersome to perform document comparison, requiring multiple downloads and uploads. With iManage Work, it's a more seamless process and documents can be opened directly for comparison from within the iManage Work system.

Another requirement for their document management system was the ability to keep all contract drafts, versions, and supporting documents organized in one place – the electronic workspace – even when working with drafts from outside firms. With the web-based document management system, versioning was a complex, multi-step and error-prone process. In addition, the system had no natural way to save Microsoft® Outlook email as part of the contract workflow. iManage Work, in contrast, has native support for document versioning and supports the automated filing of Outlook email and attachments directly into the appropriate contract folder; it can even suggest to which electronic file given emails are likely to be related.

#### Seamless Integration Enhances User Experience

Tight, out-of-the-box integration with Microsoft Office and the legal-specific applications the attorneys use on a day-to-day basis not only simplified implementation for Gamarra and his team, *“It enhances user productivity and experience.
